# Insch CC Audax Saturday 2 September (Closing Date for Entry is 20 August)

So far only 2 club members have signed up for the Audaxes (though we have had generous offers of Scones/Cakes/Macaroni pies and Tea Urns – thanks everyone.

I know that the 200km event is a serious undertaking but the 100km is a distance we often cover on Sunday rides so it would be nice to have a few more Insch shirts out on 2 September – sign up below – it's a lot cheaper than Ride the North.

The <u>Insch by Insch (200km) and Half Insch (100km) Audaxes</u> on Saturday 2 September will start and finish at St Drostan's Church Hall. The event start will be 0730 for all riders with finish by 2130 for the slowest 200km riders.

#### **OTHER NEWS/Non-Club Events**

Looking around the area there are a few different rides that might be of interest to members:

13 August – Brewdog Ride Out Sportive from Ellon

**Ride The North** 26 August – this year starting and finishing at Huntly. Registration is now closed.

9 September- The Bealach Mor, at 144km, is the bigger brother of the Bealach Beag (78km) which takes place in May. The Bealach na Ba is the UK's biggest road climb with a 626m ascent from sea level in just 10km. It is set in a fabulous unspoilt landscape with outstanding views of the sea and the hills. The Applecross Peninsula is renowned as a gem in Scotland's crown of natural wonders.

1 October - Methlick Cycle Challenge postponed from July, date yet to be confirmed; Enter via the British Cycling online entry system. Three routes will be available:

- 54 mile gravel challenge
- also a 23 mile mini gravel challenge
- and a <u>74 mile road route</u> taking in the best of Formartine and Buchan.

7 October – <u>Kayleigh's Wee Stars</u> now starting from Newmachar and offering a 54 mile route or Kayleigh's Big Star 90 mile route.

11 November – Moray Poppy Ride

#### **Routine Rides**
