# **OTHER NEWS/Non-Club Events**

Looking around the area there are a few different rides that might be of interest to members:

9 September- <u>The Bealach Mor</u>, at 144km, is the bigger brother of the Bealach Beag (78km) which takes place in May. The Bealach na Ba is the UK's biggest road climb with a 626m ascent from sea level in just 10km. It is set in a fabulous unspoilt landscape with outstanding views of the sea and the hills. The Applecross Peninsula is renowned as a gem in Scotland's crown of natural wonders.

16 September – <u>Tayside Challenge</u> 2 x scenic routes (40 and 80 miles) starting and ending in Pitcairngreen Perthshire

1 October - <u>Methlick Cycle Challenge</u> postponed from July; Enter via the British Cycling online entry system. Three routes will be available:

- 54 mile gravel challenge
- also a <u>23 mile mini gravel challenge</u>
- and a <u>74 mile road route</u> taking in the best of Formartine and Buchan.

7 October – <u>Kayleigh's Wee Stars</u> now starting from Newmachar and offering a 54 mile route or Kayleigh's Big Star 90 mile route.

7 October – Mulin Muirs 200km Audax from Newport on Tay

11 November – Moray Poppy Ride

# **Routine Rides**
